## Guidelines/Rules

- ❖ All classes are \$30 each.
- ❖ Everyone who comes onto the event grounds will be required to sign any waivers and wear any personal protective equipment (ie masks) required by current local, state and federal guidelines as well as USEF and USEA guidelines. Failure to do so will result in expulsion from the grounds. Thank you for your consideration and patience.
- ❖ Entries will be limited to 50 competitors. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
- ❖ Entries must include full payment, current Coggins test, signed Release, and mailed to the Secretary.
- ❖ ASTM/SEI approved protective helmets must be worn by riders at all times when mounted.
- ❖ This is a sanctioned dressage show and run in accordance with USEF/USDF rules.
- ❖ No refunds permitted. Entry may be put towards a future event.
- ❖ All divisions will be split junior/senior if entries permit.
- ❖ There will be six ribbon places per division.
- ❖ Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be split Junior/Senior. Rider must compete in two tests within the same level to qualify.
- ❖ Ride times will be posted by 10PM the Thursday before event on [saddlebrookstables.org](http://saddlebrookstables.org) and/or emailed by the show secretary.
- ❖ Please make checks payable to Saddlebrook Stables.
- ❖ Returned checks are subject to a \$50 returned check fee.
- ❖ Liability Release – Must be correctly filled out and attached to this form.
- ❖ All riders under 18 must have a signed liability release attached. (Signed by parent or guardian)

## **SADDLEBROOK STABLES DRESSAGE SCHOOLING SHOW HORSE RIDING AGREEMENT AND LIABILITY RELEASE FORM**

*This form must be completed by and for each participant.*

PREMISES OWNERS NAME IS Paul and Wanda Escobar, herein after known as Saddlebrook Stables. LOCATION OR ADDRESS: 975 Rocky Ford Road; Powhatan, VA23139, United States of America.

SADDLEBROOK STABLES DOES NOT GUARANTEE YOUR SAFETY OR THAT OF YOUR HORSE.  
IT IS HEREBY AGREED TO AS FOLLOWS THAT:

A. REGISTRATION OF RIDERS AND AGREEMENT PURPOSE I, the following individual herein after known as the "RIDER", and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor, do hereby voluntarily request and agree to participate in horse riding on premises of Saddlebrook Stables, and that this RIDER will ride his/her own horse or one borrowed or leased by RIDER'S own arrangement today and on all future dates:

B. AGREEMENT SCOPE AND TERRITORY AND DEFINITIONS – This agreement shall be legally binding upon me the registered RIDER, and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor, my heirs, estate, assigns, including all minor children, and personal representatives; and it shall be interpreted according to the laws of Powhatan, Virginia, United States of America. Any disputes by the RIDER shall be litigated in and venue shall be Powhatan County, Virginia.

The term "HORSE" herein shall refer to all equine species. The term "HORSEBACK RIDING" or "RIDING" herein shall refer to riding or otherwise handling of horses, ponies, mules, or donkeys, whether from the ground or mounted. The term "RIDER" shall herein refer to a person who rides a horse mounted or otherwise handles or comes near a horse from the ground.

The terms "I", "me", "my" shall herein refer to the above registered rider and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor.

C. ACTIVITY RISK CLASSIFICATION – Horseback riding is classified as RUGGED ADVENTURE RECREATIONAL SPORT ACTIVITY, and that there are numerous obvious and non-obvious inherent risks always present in such activity despite all safety precautions. According to NEISS (National Electronic Injury Surveillance Systems of United States Consumer Products) horse activities rank 64th among the activities of people relative to injuries that result in a stay at U.S. hospitals. Related injuries can be severe, requiring more hospital days and resulting in more lasting residual effects than injuries in other activities.

D. NATURE OF RIDING HORSES – No horse is a completely safe horse. Horses are 5 to 15 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful, and 3 to 4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to ground it will generally be at a distance of from 3 1/2 to 5 1/2 feet, and the impact may result in injury to the rider. Horseback riding is the only sport where on much smaller, weaker predator animal (human) tries to impose its will on, and become on unit of movement with, another much larger, stronger prey animal with a mind of its own (horse) and each has a limited understanding of the other. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its natural survival instincts which may include, but are not limited to: stopping short, changing directions or speed at will; shifting its weight; bucking; rearing; kicking; biting; or running from danger.

E. RIDER RESPONSIBILITY – Upon mounting a horse and taking up the reins, the RIDER is in primary control of the horse. The RIDER'S safety largely depends upon his/her ability to carry out

simple instructions, and his/her ability to remain balanced aboard the moving animal. The RIDER shall be responsible for his/her own safety.

F. CONDITIONS OF NATURE– Saddlebrook Stables is NOT responsible for total or partial acts, occurrences, or elements of nature that can scare a horse, cause it to fall, or react in some other unsafe way. SOME EXAMPLES ARE: thunder, lightning, rain, wind, wild and domestic animals, insects, reptiles, which may walk, run, fly near, bite and/or sting a horse or person; and irregular footing on out-of-door groomed or wild land which is subject to constant change in condition according to weather, temperature, and natural and man-made changes in landscape.

G. INSPECTION OF PREMISES – RIDER has inspected Saddlebrook Stables facilities and trails and is satisfied that all premises conditions are reasonably safe for RIDER’S intended purpose, usage and presence upon the Saddlebrook Stables premises.

H. ACCIDENT/MEDICAL AND PERSONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE – Should medical treatment be required, I and/or my own accident/medical insurance company shall pay for all such incurred expenses. Should my actions or that of my horse cause injury or damage of any kind, I and/or my own personal liability shall pay for such damages.

I. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WARNING – I have been fully warned and advised by Saddlebrook Stables that the RIDER should purchase and wear protective headgear(riding helmet), and that the wearing of such headgear while mounting, riding, dismounting, and otherwise being around horses, may prevent or reduce severity of some head injuries and even prevent death from happening as the result of a fall or other occurrence. Minors ALL RIDERS are required to wear protective headgear at all times while mounted.

J. LIABILITYRELEASE– In consideration of Saddlebrook Stables allowing my participation in this activity, under the terms set forth herein, I, the RIDER, and the parent or guardian thereof if a minor, do agree to hold harmless and release Saddlebrook Stables, its owners, agents, employees, officers, members, premises owners, insurers, and affiliated organizations from legal liability due to Saddlebrook Stables ordinary negligence; and I do further agree *that except in the event of Saddlebrook Stables gross negligence and willful and wanton misconduct*, I shall not bring any claims, demand, legal actions and causes of action, against Saddlebrook Stables and/or its associates, for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward in relation to the premises and operations of Saddlebrook Stables, to include while riding, handling, or otherwise being near horses owned by or in the care, custody and control of Saddlebrook Stables.
